

Appendix to Behaviour Policy: Response to COVID 19

June 2020

This policy appendix should be read in conjunction with the current TRAT behaviour policy.

In light of the preventative measures that are being implemented in school to minimise the risk of the spread of coronavirus, all children will be expected to follow the procedures and rules outlined below:

- Follow daily routines instructions on where they will learn, play, have lunch
- Follow instructions on hygiene; remembering to frequently wash their hands handwashing and sanitising.
- Following instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school.
- Move around the school following instructions given
- Remember to follow expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal (in line with the "catch it, bin it, kill it" message) and should avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes
- Tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- Rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles.
- Children to ask to go to the toilet so that maximum numbers are not exceeded
- NO biting, coughing or spitting at or towards any other person.

When discussing these rules and procedures, all staff should closely link them to our school code:

Be kind, be honest, be responsible, show respect and try our best

ALL CHILDREN MUST BE REMINDED OF THESE RULES AND PROCEDURES ON A DAILY BASIS

Risk assessments:

A risk assessment will be carried out in relation to any children who may find it more challenging to follow these rules. In the unlikely circumstance of a child deliberately putting staff at risk or, despite the best efforts of staff, a child being unable to adhere to the rules of social distancing, a member of the Senior Leadership Team will seek an immediate conversation with the parents/carers to explore alternative options for the continued education of that child.
